

Key Objectives for Year Five and Six

Reading	
UR1	Use knowledge of morphology and etymology to read aloud and understand new words
UR2	Make comparisons within and across books
UR3	Read a range of modern fiction, fiction from literary heritage and books from other cultures and traditions
UR4	Identify and discuss themes and conventions across a wide range of writing
UR5	Discuss understanding of texts, including exploring meaning of words in context
UR6	Ask questions to improve understanding of texts
UR7	Summarise ideas drawn from more than one paragraphs, identifying key details
UR8	Predict future events from details stated and implied
UR9	Identify how language, structure and presentation contribute to meaning
UR10	Discuss how authors use language, including figurative language, to affect the reader
UR11	Make book recommendations, giving reasons for choices
UR12	Participate in discussions about books, building on and challenging ideas
UR13	Explain and discuss understanding of reading
UR14	Participate in formal presentations and debates about reading
